No ‘off the shelf’ solution is appropriate in these settings. They require scalability and the ability to customize for both content and workflow,” said Joe Landau, president. “For smaller practices we’ve developed a solution that can be implemented without large investment in either hardware or software. “

Instant access to patient charts and billing information, with complete control of access permissions are among the key benefits of adopting a unified EMR and practice management solution.

“VersaForm overcomes many of the objections physicians have had using separate systems. In many cases the difficulties in getting different systems to communicate with each other were insurmountable,” said Landau. “A single system installs simply, and doesn’t need customization”.

VersaForm 3.0 runs on Windows 2000 or Windows XP, and utilizes the Microsoft SQL Server database. This choice of database provides professional database privacy, security and recovery features, with excellent scalability, while requiring no additional expense at all for the small office. For larger clinics, SQL Server can be run on Microsoft Windows 2003 Server, which supports multi-CPU machines and failover clusters.

VersaForm 3.0 is available now. The EMR, Charting, Prescription, and Practice Management modules can be ordered together or separately. Additional modules can be added at any time. Physicians or organizations interested in field trials are invited to contact the company.
